

## **Matura paper: topical inspiration**

### **Matura paper with focus on research:**

- Analyse the character development of a protagonist in a novel
- Analyse the setting and its functions in a novel / short story
- Compare two dystopian / utopian novels / short stories
- Analyse the historical background of a novel / play
- Analyse the narrative techniques in a novel / short story / play
- Compare fairy tales of two different time periods or cultural contexts
- Interpret and compare poems
- Analyse the representation of a specific literary topic in a novel / short story / play / film: How is this representation rendered narratologically?
- Historical and political background: How do the political ideas presented in a novel / play compare to actual political events?
- High school experience / Foreign exchange year experience: How do different educational systems / learning methods / etc. compare?
- Compare a novel with a movie of a similar topic and compare the two pieces of art

### **Creative Matura papers:**

- Write an autobiography
- Transform a novel / short story into a play
- Transform a novel / short story into a graphic novel
- Write a screenplay based on selected scenes of a novel
- Change a literary element of a narrative (e.g. narrative perspective, setting, etc.) and rewrite the story
- Write your own play / short story / poems
- Write a diary from the perspective of a character in a novel / short story / play
- Rewrite parts of a novel / short story from the perspective of a minor character
- Write an additional chapter / a different ending to a novel using the same writing style as the author
- Write an additional act to a play using the same writing style as the author
- Create and record an audiobook (with or without using a model text)
